# REPORT ON #YaARIYouthAgainstRagging ANTI-RAGGING WEEK CELEBRATIONS (AUG 12-16) 2024

#### Introduction

The Anti-Ragging Cell of our institution successfully conducted the Anti-Ragging Week celebrations from the 5th of July, aligning with the guidelines set by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The week was marked by a series of impactful activities aimed at creating awareness among students about the legal, ethical, and social implications of ragging. The event's success is a testament to our institution's commitment to maintaining a safe and inclusive environment for all students.

### **Inauguration of Anti-Ragging Cell Activities**

The Anti-Ragging Week commenced with the formal inauguration of the Anti-Ragging Cell activities on the 5th of July. The event was graced by the Chief Guest, Shri Bejoy T. P., Circle Inspector of Police, whose presence underscored the seriousness of the issue. Shri Bejoy T. P. delivered a comprehensive briefing on the legal consequences of ragging, emphasizing the strict actions taken by law enforcement against offenders. He also highlighted the ethical implications, reminding students that ragging is not just a punishable offense but a violation of human dignity.

#### **Awareness Programs**

Throughout the first week of July, a series of awareness programs were conducted at various levels, including class-level, department-level, and institution-level sessions. These sessions were designed to educate students about the harmful effects of ragging and the importance of fostering a culture of respect and support within the student community.

- 1. Senior Students Awareness Session: Shri Santhosh, Sub-Inspector of Police, Pazhayannur, led an awareness session specifically for senior students. This session was instrumental in reinforcing the message that senior students have a crucial role in setting a positive example for their juniors, and that any involvement in ragging activities would have severe legal repercussions.
- 2. Freshers' Awareness Session: A dedicated session for first-year students was conducted by Ms. Sangeetha M.P., the staff counselor. Ms. Sangeetha emphasized that any incidents of ragging should be reported immediately, and assured the students of full support from the institution in addressing any concerns.

#### **Creative and Educational Activities**

To engage students in a more interactive and reflective manner, a variety of creative and educational activities were organized. These activities not only provided a platform for students to express their views on ragging but also helped in spreading the message of anti-ragging across the campus.

- 1. Essay Writing Competition: An essay writing competition was held on the topic "Ragging: A Violation of Human Rights." The competition saw enthusiastic participation from students across various departments, with essays highlighting the devastating impact of ragging on individuals and the importance of upholding human rights in educational institutions.
- 2. Cartoon Contest: A cartoon-making contest was organized with the theme "From Pranks to Penalties: The Reality of Ragging." This contest encouraged students to use their creativity to depict the harsh realities and consequences of ragging through visual art.
- 3. Poster Making and Slogan Writing: Another engaging activity was the poster-making competition on the theme "No Ragging Because Dreams Deserve Respect and Support." Accompanied by a slogan-writing contest, these activities were aimed at visually reinforcing the anti-ragging message across the campus.
- 4. Role Play: A role-play event titled "United Against Ragging" was also conducted, where students dramatized scenarios related to ragging and its consequences. This activity served as a powerful tool to convey the anti-ragging message in a relatable and impactful manner.
- 5. Al Painting and Logo Making: In an effort to incorporate modern technology, an Al painting competition and a logo-making contest were also organized. These activities encouraged students to explore new mediums of expression while promoting the anti-ragging campaign.
- 6. Awareness Movie Screening: An impactful awareness movie was screened during the week, providing students with a visual understanding of the emotional and psychological toll that ragging can take on individuals. The movie was carefully selected to resonate with the students and to further reinforce the anti-ragging message.

#### Mass Awareness Initiatives

In addition to the aforementioned activities, the Anti-Ragging Week also included large-scale awareness initiatives to engage the broader student community.




